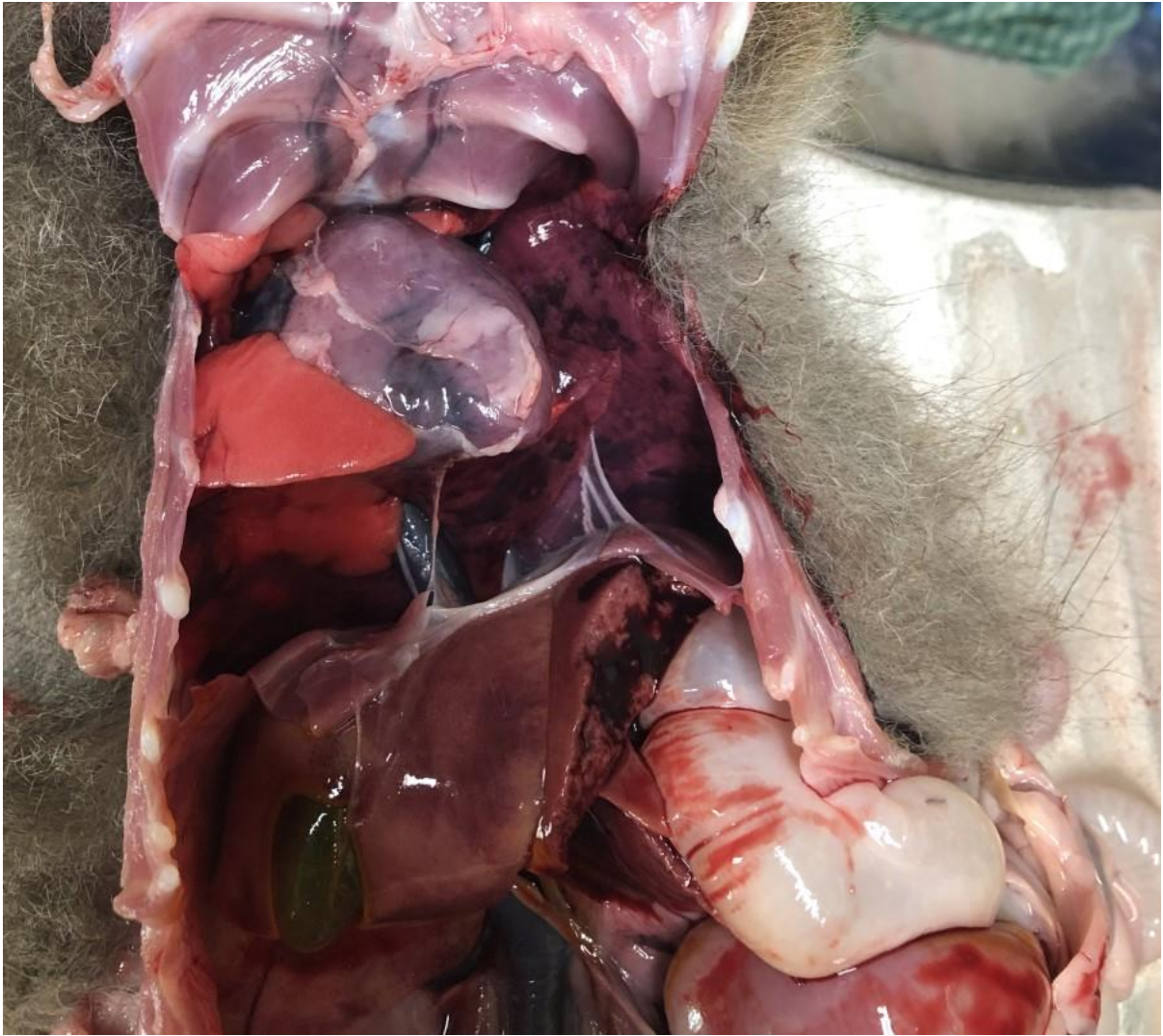


Juvenile Red Necked Wallaby Autopsy 13<sup>th</sup> December 2019



Hi Phil,

Thanks so much for offering to do a necropsy. That is Awesome!

I will ring you in a minute, but here is what we are looking for:

- Aseptically collect brain, liver, kidney, spleen, half of any lesion into sterile cryovials and freeze asap at – 80C if possible
- collect a bit of each tissue type into formalin
- collect a renal impression smear and brain squash preparation – methanol fixed for 5 mins
- photos of any lesions.

The formalin can be poured off Monday and the samples (formalin fixed – triple bagged, with just a formalin soaked cotton ball) express posted to us with the impression smear/squash prep bagged separately via:
