Specimen: SPECIMENS X 2

Macroscopic: (MM/SP)

1. Kidney/spleen: Two specimens received in the same container, the first is a brown portion of tissue with the appearance of kidney with attached light tan fatty tissue measuring in toto 30 x 20 x 11mm. 2RTS in A. The second specimen received in the same container is a brown portion of tissue with attached light tan fatty tissue measuring in toto 17 x 12 x 6mm. 2RTS, B.

2. Brain/liver: Two specimens received in the same container, the first is a light tan portion of tissue 40 x 14 x 7mm. 3RTS in C. The second specimen received in the container is a brown portion of tissue 35 x 15 x 7mm. 3RTS taken in D.

Microscopic:

Kidney, spleen, brain, liver: No significant lesions.

The cause of death is not evident from evaluation of these tissues. There is no evidence of a systemic infectious process (including toxoplasmosis).

ADDENDUM REPORT (9.11.16):
