1220gram 18/10/2016 Joey had a strange turn at lunchtime, noticed he was very slow to drink his bottle and when on the ground he was shaking and not wanting to move. Later in the afternoon the shaking became acute, I gave him 0.2 mil of Diazapam and 0.02 Meloxicam and took him inside. Later that evening he settled down, drank 45 mil of lectade. I kept him inside overnight and the next morning he drank his bottle as usual, plus water and he went back outside in the enclosure. He seems fine at this stage.

21/10/2016 Joey had the same turn again in the late afternoon 20/10, treatment repeated. Kept him inside till the following afternoon when he seemed totally recovered. That night he browsed in the pen, drank his bottle and water from the bowl. So far all seems normal.

25/10/16 At 2pm joey was fine drank his bottle and water, hopping in pen etc. Came into the pen at 5-30pm and he was dead on the ground.
